ETWINNING CHRISTMAS CARDS EXCHANGE

The project carried out by the Special School on the eTwinning platform is called Christmas Cards Exchange. Teacher Daniela Andrei participated in the project. The member countries that participated in the project are: Portugal, Spain, Serbia, Greece, Romania and Italy. The key competences targeted in this project were citizenship, cultural awareness and expression, digital competences, entrepreneurship, literacy.

The project is based on the exchange of Christmas cards between European schools. It is intended for teachers and students new to eTwinning. Postcards can be made in English or in the language of each participating country. The curriculum areas related to this project are: Language of the country of origin, English Language, Artistic Ed. and Musical Ed. For the development of this project, we took into account the principles of inclusion, cooperation and equality in all activities.

The objectives of the project were:

- engaging the educational community in the spirit of Christmas to share and give cards to other children in European schools
- improving the language competence to write simple cards/congratulations
- stimulating entrepreneurial actions by making contact with students from other countries
- learning a foreign language increases students' competence to express themselves in a spoken language
- establishing links with other schools for future collaborative projects

The project started on 28.11.2022 with an online meeting with the participating teachers, a whatsapp group was created. The students made Christmas cards together with the coordinating teacher. Since December 7th we have been sending Christmas cards to other schools. December 8-9: each school voted on their favorite logo proposal and uploaded it to PADLET by posting the name of the school and the teacher. During December 12-16 we voted on the LOGO of the project. The survey will be online and each teacher can share the link on

their social networks.
